All riders ride at their own risk and hard hats must be worn whilst mounted.

Correct riding attire must be worn. No trainers, wellies or jeans.

Children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult.

Excessive use of a crop/whip will result in elimination.

All dogs must be kept on leads and under strict control at all times.  
Any horses/ponies that are tied to lorries/trailers are not left unattended.  
That you DO NOT skip out your trailer or lorry onto the premises and that you clean any hay/ droppings up around your vehicle and take it with you when you leave.

The organiser reserves the right to cancel any class. Entries may be restricted, please note on entry if happy to be waitlisted.  
No refund will be made after the close of entries unless a vet/ doctor's certificate produced.

Failure to phone for times may result in elimination.
