

Pony Club Camp Proposed Itinerary

Below gives a taste of what riders should expect at this year's camp subject to weather etc!

23rd August 2010

Arrive at camp bright and early. Sort out your sleeping quarters!!
Get your pony in and organise hay, water & bedding. Remember you're responsible for the welfare of your pony for the duration of camp and there will be various rosettes for best stable management and most improved member!

Lessons will be run throughout the day which will be split according to ability. The achievement badge for mucking out will be focused on as part of camp.

There will be a break for lunch before more activities commence. Then, you will be expected to clean tack and make sure your ponies are brushed off and ready for turn out. All stables should be prepared for the next day. There will be a yard inspection before the evening meal commences.

Early rise. Ponies fetched in from the field then breakfast. We always provide you with a full English breakfast or just some cereal if you prefer!
